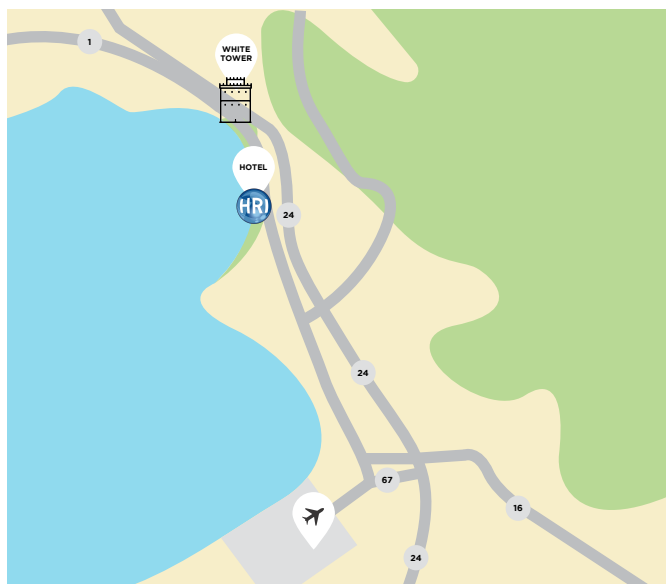
The Makedonia Palace Hotel is just a 25-minute drive from Thessaloniki Airport (SKG).
